He could be frustrating but also wonderful in all the days of his young life. He was a graduate of Seminole High School. After a short break, he joined the US Army where he served a deployment in Iraq. After his discharge from the army, he graduated from Universal Technical Institute. His graduation announcement included a long list of accolades such as student of the course and perfect attendance. He loved cars and working with his hands. He had multiple vehicles that did not stay "stock" for long. He was a great man with a great mind.
