Reverend Mark Anthony Paez, 54, born November 26th, 1959 in Houston, Texas, passed away on Tuesday, February 25, 2014 in Dallas.

Mark received the call to serve God in the ministry at the age of 10. He graduated from Denton High school in 1978. Later he attended Alpha Bible institute and graduated with honors.
